To make the most of this interactive educational experience, we have provided some guidelines to assist you in preparing your students. Prior to your field trip we ask you to:

1. Encourage your student to research the symbols and help them to learn the importance of each one.

3. Request that your students make informational posters about the symbols to bring on your field trip and display in the Children's Village

6. The Bald Eagle
7. The Liberty Bell
8. The Statue of Liberty

10. Lady Justice
