SCOUT OUT SOME FUN AT THE MAGIC HOUSE!
Scout Workshops and Camp-Ins
October – May

ST LOUIS (July 21, 2010) – Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts are invited to troop on over to The Magic House for their next scouting adventure. The Magic House offers a variety of scout programs that feature fun and challenging activities for scouts to participate in. Whether they are earning a badge or camping in the great indoors, scouts are sure to have a magical time. Scout's Honor!

During the school year, **Scout Workshops** for Cub Scout and Girl Scout troops are available on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays at 4:00 pm, on select Fridays at 4:00 pm, 5:15 pm or 6:30 pm and on select Saturdays at 10:00 am, 11:15 am, 1:00 pm and 2:45 pm. These programs meet requirements for **Daisies** (Daisy Girl Scout in Action); **Brownies** (Science in Action Try-It, Science Wonders Try-It and Colors & Shapes Try-It); **Juniors** (Science Discovery Badge, Art in 3D Badge and Drawing and Painting Badge); **Bears** (Electricity and Nature Craft Electives and Art Electives) and **Webelos** (Scientist Activity Badge and Artist Activity Badge). Scout Workshops are \$8.75 per scout and \$8.75 per person for all accompanying adults and leaders.

The Magic House also offers **Camp-Ins** for Brownies, Juniors, Bears and Webelos. Scout groups can camp inside “under the exhibits” and have The Magic House all to themselves on select Fridays from October through May. Campers explore the more than 100 hands-on exhibits in The Magic House, enjoy an evening snack and light breakfast, sleep among the exhibits, take part

in fun badge activities and receive a special Magic House patch. The cost is \$32 per person and at least one adult is required for every five scouts. A \$50 nonrefundable deposit is due when making reservations.

About The Magic House, St. Louis Children's Museum

The Magic House is a not-for-profit participatory museum that provides hands-on learning experiences for children and families that encourage experimentation, creativity and the development of problem-solving skills within a place of beauty, wonder, joy and magic. Regular museum admission is \$8.75 per person.

Children under the age of one are free.

The Magic House is located at 516 S. Kirkwood Road, one mile north of Highway 44 in historic downtown Kirkwood. Hours during the school year are Tuesday through Thursday, 12:00 pm to 5:30 pm, Friday 12:00 pm to 9:00 pm, Saturday 9:30 am to 5:30 pm and Sunday 11:00 am to 5:30 pm. The museum is closed on Mondays during the school year. Parking is always free at The Magic House.
