Weeklong Summer Camps coming to The Magic House and MADE for Kids

Weeklong, half-day camps are offered at The Magic House for 5- to 6-year-olds and 6- to 8-year-olds and full-day camps for 8- to 11-year-olds. Camps at MADE for Kids are weeklong, full-day camps for kids ages 6-8, 8-11, and 11-13.

At Camp Magic House, campers participate in fun hands-on activities and explore Museum exhibits. Whether campers are embarking on an artistic adventure or unleashing their inner inventor, Camp Magic House is sure to spark their imagination.

Half-day camps at The Magic House take place from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. Each session features new themes and activities. The cost for the weeklong, half-day camps is \$150 per camper per session.

Full-day camps take place from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. The cost is \$275 per camper per session.
